"How many kinds of moral and material poverty we face today as a result of denying God and putting so many idols in his place."

Lord God, lover of the poor, hear us and transform us that we may manifest your love and care to all humanity.

<u>School Form Signing – NOTE THE DATE!</u> Applications for Secondary Schools are now open, with most schools having the deadline of 31<sup>st</sup> October. Check the paperwork carefully and be sure to apply in good time! We are very blessed to have a fine Catholic secondary school, De La Salle, right in the centre of the parish, which has just had an £8 million rebuild and refurbishment.

Families looking for an all boys school or all girls school also have good choices nearby with St Thomas More in Southend and the Ursuline School in Brentwood. We strongly and warmly encourage Catholic families to use Catholic schools: there is an ethos and set of values that underpin these schools rooted in the Catholic faith, and it is a priceless gift to your child, sustaining all that happens in the parish and in the home. Each school has detailed admissions criteria, and **will require a form to be signed to show your child is a Baptised Catholic and attending Mass.** 

<u>Please bring the forms from the school with you and complete the whole form</u> with the exception of the questions which need to be answered by the priest. If they have not provided a supplementary form about your faith then Fr Dominic will provide one for you. <u>You will also need a copy of your child's</u> <u>Baptism certificate</u> – if you do not have this then the form cannot be signed. If your child was Baptised in Basildon (at any of our three churches) then call Katrina, 01268 281732, and request a new copy.

There will be around ninety forms for Fr Dominic to sign. For this reason please do not ask for them to be signed individually after Masses, but instead please come at the following times:

#### Harvest Offering – supporting those in need

The Basildon Community Resource Centre provides food and essentials to the most isolated and vulnerable citizens of our local community. On the weekend of **12<sup>th</sup> / 13<sup>th</sup> October** <u>**ONLY**</u> we are asking parishioners to place food parcels, in a plastic bag or box, close to one of the altars in any of our three churches. Thank you in anticipation of your kind generosity.

Items that can be stored and used easily include: **long life milk / sugar / tin potatoes** / tin vegetables / tin fruit / **pasta sauces / rice / jam** / deserts (*Angel delight etc*) / baked beans / pot noodles / **bottled squash** / **shower gel** / toothpaste / talc & nappies / **coffee / tin meat /** tin pies / **cereals /** tin tomatoes / **carton juice / tin sauces / marmalade** /evaporated milk / tin spaghetti / packet noodles / **can openers** / soap / toothbrushes / wet wipes / teabags / tin fish / tin soup / packet soup / dried pasta / **biscuits** / jar sauces / tin sausages / peanut butter / tin milk puddings / gravy granules / deodorant / shampoo/conditioner / disposable razors. *Items in bold needed urgently*. Please, please no fresh produce or out of date items.

**Struggling with debt? Finding it hard to budget?** CAP Money is a serious, friendly and down to earth look at money management. Trained coaches will help you get things back on track, or work out family budgets. There is also more help for those facing bailiffs or caught up with loan companies like Wonga or payday loans.
