THE BIG BUTTERFLY COUNT will be running until 4th August. Research has proved that spending just 15 minutes observing and counting butterflies can help reduce anxiety and boost wellbeing. Our butterflies and moths are under serious threat and the more people that join in (and possibly become members of The Butterfly Conservation) the more help we can give these beautiful creatures.

BEES: Have you noticed less bees around this year than there were last year? Around 70 crops in the UK alone rely on bee pollination. However, a neonicotinoid that harms bees was approved by the last government for emergency use on UK farms for four years in a row. Just one teaspoon of this pesticide can kill a billion bees!
